



The Knightly Order of St. Catherine with Mount Sinai

Ambassador of Belarus of the Knightly Order of St. Catherine with Mount Sinai ("the Order")

1. Organization and Administration

- 1.1 His Royal Highness Prince Louis de Lusignan Kalfa-Nar-bey shall be the Sovereign of the Order.*
- 1.2 It shall be competent for the Chancellery or the Chancellor for Foreign Affairs to make decisions on general purposes of the Order.*
- 1.3 The Chancellery or the Chancellor for Foreign Affairs shall have the judicial power in the Order.*
- 1.4 The Embassy of Belarus shall be governed by an Ambassador. The Ambassador shall be appointed by the Chancellery of the Chancellor for Foreign Affairs. The area of activities of the Embassy covers the whole territory of Belarus.*
- 1.5 Commanderies shall be governed by Commanders. Commanders shall be appointed by the Ambassador of Belarus. Area of activities of Commanderies shall be large areas.*

2. Membership and Qualifications

- 2.1 A person, who wants to enter the Order, shall deliver an application with full personal details to the Chancellery or the Chancellor for Foreign Affairs of the Order.*
- 2.2 The Chancellery of the Order shall process the application for membership and issue the Letters Patent or Certificate of Membership.*
- 2.3 Persons who have rendered meritorious and faithful services to the Sovereign may be admitted in the Order immediately and directly by the Sovereign.*

The Appointment was issued on May 23, 2023.
